Job Summary

Incumbent will use web-based technologies for social media and interaction, such as creating social marketing publications for the tobacco program; using social interaction through activities, such as blogging, etc.; community development and management through media publications, such as creating posters, flyers, digital story-telling, etc. Duties will involve contact with a diverse population and a varied schedule that may include some weekends, evenings, and holidays.

This position description may not include all of the listed duties, nor do all of the listed examples include all tasks which may be found or assigned to this position.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Participates in all leadership training initiatives on commercial tobacco and tribal tobacco, which the TTCPP organizes and participates with, such as other tribal tobacco training.
- Will participate in the planning of age-appropriate activities that include, but not limited to, social activities, such as arts and crafts, music, education workshops, and community presentations, such as health fairs, and develop posters, flyers, etc.
- Will establish and maintain various social media interaction, such as Facebook and other social media venues.
- Participate in the planning of a social media and social marketing plan to increase the visibility, information driven to increase the awareness of tribal tobacco and commercial tobacco.
- Completes required forms and documents in accordance with policies and grant reporting
- Performs other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications

- High School Diploma or GED.
- 18 years or older and own computer or have access to a computer
- Having an understanding of the Mescalero Apache culture
- Have a desire to learn about commercial tobacco and traditional tobacco
- Have knowledge on graphic designing, marketing, new social media endeavors, etc.

Tribal preference and Native American Indian preference shall apply to all positions.

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Ability to communicate effectively—verbally and written
- Ability to work independently and follow scheduled plans
- Creative thinking and ability to strategize is important in this field

- Have knowledge in social media tools and techniques
- Have the knowledge of good marketing and communication skills

Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, the employee regularly is required to stand; sit; use hands and fingers, handle, or feel; reach with hands and arms; talk or hear; and taste or smell. The employee frequently is required to walk. The employee occasionally is required to climb or balance; and stand; and stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl. The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 40 pounds. Also, must be able to sit and drive for hours at a time.

Work is generally performed in an interior work environment and outside environment. Some evening, weekend, and/or holiday work will be required and extended hours and irregular shifts may be required.
