SBA New Mexico Hosts Disaster Recovery Webinars in English and Spanish for the South Fork Fire, Salt Fire & Flooding Disaster Upcoming Deadline: August 19, 2024

NEW MEXICO—The <u>U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA)</u> <u>New Mexico District Office</u> is hosting a webinar series in English and Spanish, "New Mexico South Fork Fire, Salt Fire & Flooding Information Session with Q&A" to assist homeowners, renters, nonprofits, and businesses affected by the New Mexico South Fork Fire, Salt Fire, & Flooding Presidential declared disaster.

The <u>SBA Office of Disaster Recovery & Resilience (ODR&R)</u>, <u>Federal Emergency Management Agency</u> (<u>FEMA</u>) and the <u>New Mexico Small Business Development Centers (SBDC</u>) will present on resources they can provide. Guest speakers from other government agencies may also present (e.g., <u>Internal Revenue Service (IRS)</u>).

- <u>Disaster Declaration #20407 & #20408 | NM-20004</u>
 Applies to **businesses**, homeowners, renters and non-profits.
 - Physical Damage Deadline: August 19, 2024
 - **Economic Injury Deadline:** March 20, 2025
- <u>Disaster Declaration #20451 & #20452 | NM-20006</u>
 Applies to Private Non-Profit (PNP) organizations that provide essential services of a governmental nature.
 - Physical Damage Deadline: September 9, 2024
 - Economic Injury Deadline: April 11, 2025

FEMA

- <u>DR-4795-NM</u>
 - o Individual Assistance (IA) Grants Deadline: August 19, 2024
