**Re: Evacuation Restrictions lifted for Windmill, Summit Drive, Mirage Lane and Fantasy Lane Residents**

**Date: June 22, 2024**

Regarding Executive Order 24-01: Evacuation restrictions have been lifted for the residents of the Windmill area, Summit Drive, Mirage Lane and Fantasy Lane residents, off highway 244 and 70, up to Apache Summit. This evacuation lift is **ONLY** open to residents in the identified areas and continues to be closed to non-residents (Chatto Run remains closed).

Residents who wish to return home **must register** with the Mescalero Apache Conservation Law Enforcement Office, 575-464-9323, at 278 Pine Street to verify their home address (must have a valid ID and **proof of residency**) and receive a vehicle placard for law enforcement officers.

Anyone who is in the area and does not have a provided vehicle placard will be issued a civil citation by Tribal law enforcement.

**Please be aware** that there may be some homes that have power outages or water shut off. In this case, please contact the Tribal Emergency Operations Center, at 575-464-9214, to communicate this information.

The Mescalero Apache Conservation Law Enforcement Office is also managing animal rescue for animals that may be displaced or hurt by the fires. Veterinary care is being provided. If you do see an animal in need, please report to the office at 575-464-9323.

Thank you for your patience and understanding while we ensure that it is safe for all Tribal members before lifting any further evacuation restrictions.
