


Situation Overview

WEDNESDAY: A little bit of lowland rain & mountain snow...A full day of strong to damaging winds

Key Messages:

- #1 Weather Hazard: Wind
 - Lowlands 40+ G 60+ mph
 - Mountains 50+ G 80+ mph
- #2 Weather Hazard: BL Dust
 - General 3-5 mi visibility
 - Local Area: 0-1/4 mi visibility
- #3 Weather Hazard: Rain/Snow
 - Lowland Rain: ISO/SCT
 - Trace to 0.20"
 - Mountain Snow: SCT/NUM
 - 1-4" SACs / 3-6" Gila





Wind Potential: Sustained & Gust Speeds

Very Strong Southwest Winds Wednesday...starting early in the day, and lasting into the evening

Key WIND Messages:

- Full Day of Strong Southwest Winds.
 - Lowland speeds
 - 40-45 mph G 60-65 mph
 - Mountain Speeds
 - 50-55 mph G 65-80 mph
- Damage to structures/ Power interruptions possible
- Travel across the region could become dangerous due to buffeting wind qusts.

Gila Region & Bootheel Mtns:

Starts: 1 am Tuesday Night

Ends: Midnight Wed Night.

Sacramento Mountains:

Starts: 1am Tuesday Night

Ends: 5 am Thursday Morning

West/Central Lowlands:


Starts: 9am Wednesday Morning

Ends: 8pm Wed Night.

Ends: Midnight Wed Night.






Dust Potential: Previous Dust Event Example

This satellite imagery of dust shows what we could see again during Wednesday's strong winds

Key DUST Messages:

- Widespread dust is possible, but could be reduced due to recent rains. Expect general visibility reduced to 3 to 5 mi.
- Localities near dust sources could see severe visibility restrictions.
 Expect visibility reduced to 0 to ¼ mi.
- Travel across the region could become dangerous due to near zero visibilities.






Mountain Snows: Tuesday Night – Wednesday

Very Strong Southwest Winds Wednesday...starting early in the day, and lasting into the evening

Key SNOW Messages:

- Snow above 5500 ft.
- Strong winds = Blowing snow and blizzard-like.
- Timing: Tue Night Wed Eve.
- Gila Region Mountains:
 - 1-2" mid-elevations
 - 4-6" higher elevations
- Sacramento Mountains:
 - 1-2" mid-elevations
 - 2-4" upper-elevations






Winter Storm Watch: GILA REGION

FOR THE MOUNTAINS across the GILA...with strong winds...blizzard conditions possible

Key Gila SNOW Messages:

- Snow levels:
 - 7000ft dropping to 5500 ft.
- Strong Winds:
 - 40-60 mph
 - Blizzard conditions poss.
- Timing:
 - Tue Night Wed Eve.
- Snow Amounts:
 - 1-2" mid-elevations
 - 4-6" higher elevations






Rainfall Amounts: Tuesday Night – Wednesday

Rain across the lowlands....liquid equivalent of snow in the mountains

Key RAIN Messages:

- Rain generally light across the lowlands:
 - Trace to 0.25" possible
- Light to moderate snow across the higher mountains:
 - 0.50"-.75" liquid amounts





Summary Overview: Tue Night – Wed Evening

Wind / Dust / Mountain Snow / Lowland Rain

- Strong Winds will be the biggest THREAT, posing the highest RISKS.
 - Wind speeds: Lowlands 40+ G 60+ mph / Mountains 50+ G 80+ mph
- Blowing Dust is a strong possibility, despite recent rains.
 - Visibilities: General 3-5 mi visibility / Local Area: 0-1/4 mi visibility
- Mountain Snows will bring hazardous conditions to Gila and Sacs.
 - Snow Amounts: 1-4" Sacramento mountains / 3-6" Gila region mountains.
 - Blizzard conditions are possible with the strong winds expected.
- Difficult and dangerous travel is likely through this period.



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
