



WHEN A WEATHER ALERT IS ISSUED RMSD WILL IMPLEMENT THE FOLLOWING PROTOCOL:

LEVEL 1: FLOOD WATCH

Conditions are favorable but nothing is happening yet. It does not mean flooding will occur, but it is possible.

Ruidoso Schools will continue normal operations.

LEVEL 2: FLOOD WARNING

Weather is imminent or occurring. Weather conditions pose a safety threat. Flooding debris is being seen.

Ruidoso Schools will go into a shelter-in-place. This means students and staff will remain on campus until conditions allow for safe travel.

LEVEL 3: FLOOD EMERGENCY

Flooding is occurring with water rescues happening and roads/bridges are compromised.

Ruidoso Schools will continue the shelter-in-place. This means students and staff will remain on campus until conditions allow for safe travel.
