In July Lola and Jessalyn traveled to Albuquerque to visit a language nest by the name of Saad K'idilye' Dine' Language Nest. This visit was very enriching to see the whole and children in this language nest all speaking Dine'.

The Apache Language & Culture program has hired 2 immersion teachers to work with the Mescalero and Carrizo head start and daycare.

These teachers will be having immersion class starting with the Mescalero Head Start at both sites and starting in January 2025, we would also like to start having immersion class with the both site of Daycare and Early childhood.

The Language program has put out advertisement for two mentor and 6 apprentices but there have not been hardly any individuals interested in either part of the master apprentice program.

The first week in September Lola, Jessalyn and Terri traveled to San Carlos to visit with their master apprentice program.

An onsite visit to one of their elementary schools and to their college was done which they learned how their programs were developed and what it took to get their program working.
